



AYSO is a parent-based volunteer non-profit organization providing a soccer program for children of any experience or skill level. The goal of AYSO Region 177 is to provide a world class youth soccer program that enriches children's lives.

We have various programs for different age groups and athletic needs and capabilities:

Jamboree (Under 5 years old Co-Ed) exposes 4 year olds to soccer and teaching soccer basics in a low pressure setting.

The CORE Program is our primary soccer program for players 5-12 years old and is separated by gender. CORE is where we play and learn soccer according to the Six Philosophies of AYSO.

The EXTRA Program offers a more serious level of soccer for AYSO players who have the interest and ability. (Participants are selected by independent, professional coaches at try-outs in the Spring for the following Tournament-Style Fall Season.)

The Upper Division Program for players ages 13-18 who want to play teams from other regions and areas within Southern California at a competitive level. (For more info click on "Upper Division" tab in menu bar above.)

The VIP (Very Important Player) Program provides a quality soccer experience for kids whose physical and mental disabilities make it difficult to successfully participate on a mainstream team.
